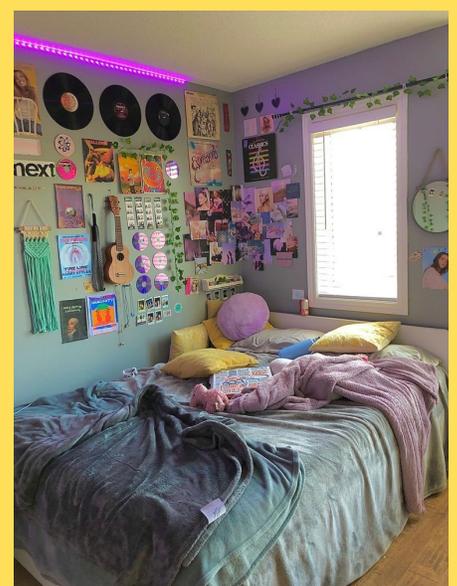

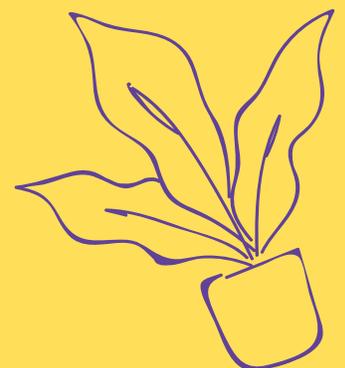

Add some decorative lights

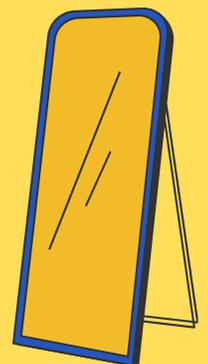
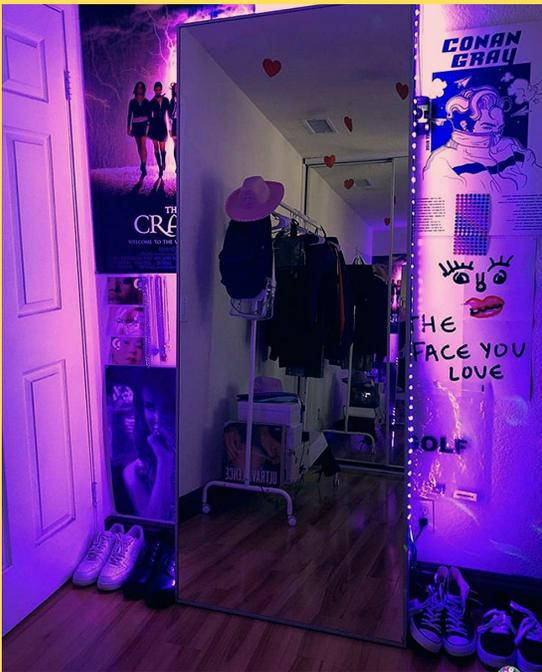

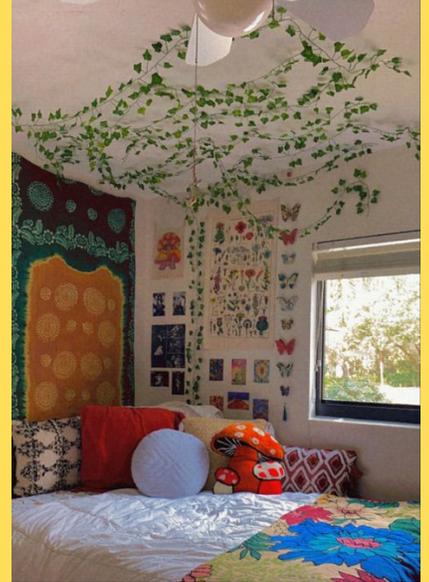


Incorporate an Oversized Mirror
